

How to Make The Treble Crochet Stitch - Quick Reference Guide

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Stitch Overview & Abbreviations:

- US Term: Treble Crochet / Triple Crochet (tr) | UK Term: Double Treble Crochet (dtr)
- Height: Extra tall stitch (twice the height of single crochet)
- Turning Chain: Chain 4 (Ch-4 usually counts as 1 treble crochet stitch)

6-Step Treble Crochet (tr) Breakdown:

Step 1 [Yarn Over Twice]: Wrap yarn over your hook TWICE (3 loops on hook).

Step 2 [Insert Hook]: Insert hook into designated stitch (or 5th chain from hook).

Step 3 [Pull Up Loop]: Yarn over and pull yarn through stitch (4 loops on hook).

Step 4 [First Pull Through]: Yarn over and pull through FIRST 2 loops (3 loops left).

Step 5 [Second Pull Through]: Yarn over and pull through NEXT 2 loops (2 loops left).

Step 6 [Final Pull Through]: Yarn over and pull through FINAL 2 loops to finish!

Pro Tips & Height Control:

- First Stitch: Since Ch-4 counts as a stitch, skip the 1st stitch and work into 2nd st.
- Last Stitch: Don't forget to work your last treble into the top of the turning ch-4!
- Uses: Ideal for light summer shawls, lace curtains, mesh market bags & fringes.

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
